

Twenty Questions

A fun get-to-know-you game for your entire chapter. You can play two ways.

Version One:

- Before the activity, make up a list of questions that include life experiences, such as:
 - Who has built a piece of furniture?
 - Who has jumped out of an airplane?
 - Who is living in the same house she grew up in?
 - Who has jumped on a trampoline?
- Choose one sister as your leader and give her the questions.
- Have everyone else sit on chairs in a large circle.
- The leader asks one question at a time. All those who answer “yes” stand in the center of the circle, tell their story, and then return to a different seat in the circle.

Version Two:

- Ahead of time, create 4x5 blocks on a sheet of paper with one question in each block. (See attached example.)
- Give a sheet to each sister.
- Have her gather signatures of sisters who fit the clue, trying to get as many different signatures as possible.
